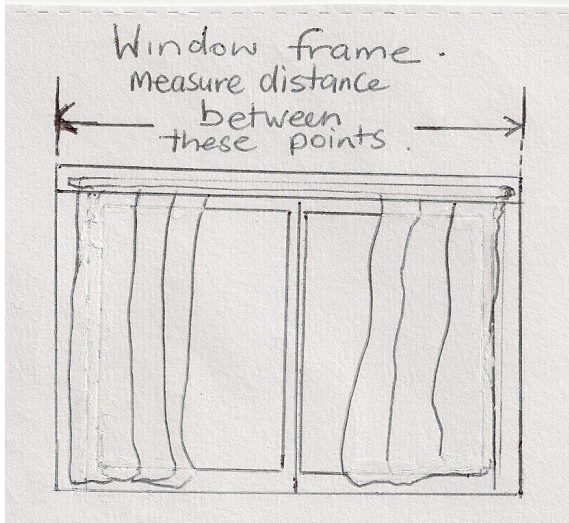

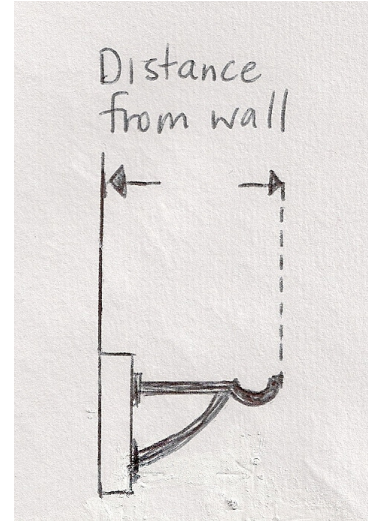
Pelmet Measurements

For pelmets we need to measure

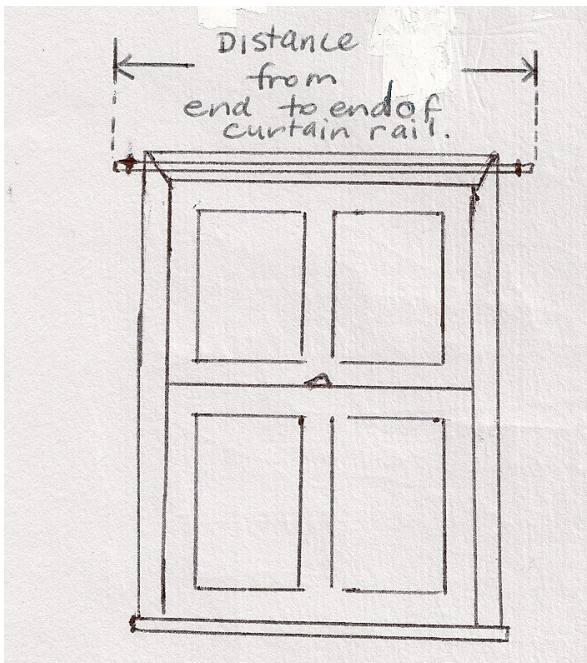
the width of the window and frame



and the distance from the wall of the curtain rod



However sometimes the rail extends beyond the window frame



Or the baton at the top extends past the curtain rod or the window frame



So measure this distance instead
